- 5). Club uniforms and individual sponsored colours (or State uniform where applicable) must be worn at all NSWCF "Opens".
- 6). All competitors representing their Club in teams events (ie; track teams pursuit, road teams time trial) must wear their Club colours which may bear their sponsor / s advertising
- 7). Competitors competing at Australian Road Championships as a Club rider must wear their registered Club colours which may bear their sponsor / s advertising.
- 8). Competitors competing at Australian Championships wearing State representative clothing may wear their sponsor / s advertising.
- 9). All competitors wearing advertising at Australian Championships must supply the team manager with a letter of sanction from that competitors Club President.

- 10). The club agrees that its members;
- a) When wearing his/her Club or sponsors clothing he/she shall at all times present himself/herself in a clean and neat manner (where practicable) and display his/her sponsor/s to the best advantage.
 - b). He/she shall (where practicable) at all times both training and racing maintain his/her cycling equipment in a clean and working condition.
 - c). He/she shall (where practicable) at all race presentations appear in his/her Club or sponsor/s clothing.
 - d). He/she shall (where practicable) compete in all events as indicated by his/her club and sponsor/s
 - e). He/she shall (where practicable) at any presentation endeavour to bring attention to his/her sponsor/s.
 - f). He/she shall (where practicable) attend all functions, media interviews, presentations etc as indicated by his/her club/sponsor/s.
 - g). Should this agreement be cancelled by either the Club or the sponsor the Club agrees to return all sponsorship in kind (bicycle equipment, clothing etc) to the sponsor/s in a clean and sound working order subject to wear and tear.

- 2) This Agreement shall cover the period commencing and will expire at midnight on December 31st of that year, unless previously terminated by consent of both member / sponsor and club.
- 3). Team/Group/Individual sponsorship can include one sponsor or more and advertising may be placed on club registered uniform (shirt, knicks, tracksuit etc.). Cycling NSW may sanction one head sponsor per team/group/individual sponsorship. A head sponsor may also become a secondary sponsor of anyother team/group/individual however their sponsorship (logo/text) must not dwarf that of an approved head sponsor.
- 4). The only advertising that may appear on a club uniform is that which has been approved by the Club Executive Committee and the NSW Cycling Federation.
- 5). Team/Group individual sponsored colours (or State uniform where applicable) must be worn at all NSWCF "Opens". Santioned NSWIS and regional academy uniforms may be worn in sanctioned open carnivals excepting NSW club championship events were Club uniforms must be worn. Application to CA for academy uniforms to be used in national championship events.
- 6) Professional and Continental team uniforms are sanctioned by the UCI and are permitted to be worn in all Cycling NSW sanctioned events.
- 7) Nationally registered teams are sanctioned by the Cycling Australia and are permitted to be worn in all Cycling NSW sanctioned events.

- 8) All other team/group/individual uniforms are to be registered and sanctioned by Cycling NSW prior to a rider being permitted to race in the new uniform. All new clothing designs excepting those in points 6 and 7 above must be approved by Cycling NSW prior to being ordered. Cycling NSW will not approve any design or colours that may clash with an already approved design.
- 9). All competitors representing their Club in teams events (ie; track teams pursuit, road teams time trial) must wear their Club colours which may bear their sponsor/s advertising
- 10). Competitors competing at Australian Road Championships as a Club rider must wear their registered Club colours which may bear their sponsor/s advertising.
- 11). Competitors competing at Australian Championships wearing State representative clothing may wear their sponsor/s advertising.
- 12). All competitors wearing advertising at Australian Championships must supply the team manager with a letter of sanction from that competitor's Club President.
- 13). The riders agrees that;
